The Board of Directors of Vancouver College sets the tuition fees annually based on projected revenues and operating costs. At our recent meeting, the VC Board set the fees for the 2025-2026 school year at \$9,700 per student, an increase of \$400 (4.3%).

Ensuring Vancouver College continues to be home to the highly qualified professionals found in our dedicated teachers and staff is of paramount importance in our ability to deliver the high standards VC is known for in its academic, athletic, artistic, and spiritual endeavors. Likewise, central to our mission is a desire to ensure the school remains affordable. We strive to maintain our tuition at a level that allows VC to be accessible to all families who seek Catholic-based education. With the increase of \$400 in next year's tuition, we believe we can balance our dual objectives of quality and accessibility during these economically challenging times.

Vancouver College remains committed to its robust Financial Assistance Program, fortified thanks to unwavering support from our Alumni and many other generous donors. We sincerely encourage families who need help meeting tuition costs and co-curricular fees to apply for assistance.
